The Tonnage opening has now been closed permanently by plating over.

All overboard scuppers from the Shelter Tween Decks have been permanently closed by removing storm valves off shell and openings plated over, scuppers now led to bilge.

The 5" Tonnage well scupper P. & S. remains and is geared to the Shelter Deck with indicator to show whether open or shut.

New Freeboards have been marked on the Ships Sides and verified.
