on dates during *March & April* 1957 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/~~made~~:-

The two after bunker hatch openings on the superstructure deck abreast engine and boiler casing, p. & s. sides, now dispensed with. Beams removed and deck openings efficiently plated over.

Accommodation deckhouses adjoining engine and boiler casing on superstructure deck extended forward by 16'0" on p.s. and 15'0" on s.s.

2- additional sanitary discharge valves, leading from the new accommodation spaces, fitted to ship sides in 'tween deck spaces p. & s., same discharging overboard above level of main deck.
