The case of the above named ship has received the consideration of the Committee today in connection with your Report No.4448 and your cablegram of the 18th instant.

The Committee note from your cablegram that, in your opinion, the vessel is neither in a fit condition to proceed to Cochin, nor to remain indefinitely laid up at your port, and accordingly, they have had to take some action in regard to the class.

They do not desire to add to the difficulties of the Owners in this unfortunate case, and although strictly speaking the class could be expunged owing to reported defects, the Committee have decided to assign a notation of "Class Suspended 8,59. - To be Broken up". This truly reflects the present circumstances, and means that no certificate should be issued on behalf of this Society.

I have cabled the above decision to you today, and shall be obliged if you will arrange for the Owners to be informed of the position.
