A proposal to carry out the above survey within the year of grace was agreed to in December last after the vessel had been generally examined at Newcastle.

The Owners now write as follows, viz:-

"As you are aware the steamer was only taken over by the present Owners early this year and owing to unfortunate circumstances the vessel had to wait over six weeks at Constantza for the opening of navigation in the Danube and consequently is only now performing her first voyage.
