This tanker was built in 1944 and classed with the American Bureau of Shipping.

The vessel has the temporary class 100A1 "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk" (Classification Contemplated) assigned and notation of "Examined 9.47".

These notations are subject to No. 3 tank being tested before different grades of oil are carried in Nos. 2 & 3 tanks and to the equipment being brought up to Rule requirements.

The Classification Survey was commenced at Liverpool in September 1947.

For full particulars of this case see previous endorsement.

The LIVERPOOL Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, the SPECIAL SURVEY FOR CLASSIFICATION completed and repairs effected.

The shell and deck plating have been cut and strapped at this time.

No. 3 tank, as above, now dealt with.

The vessel has now on board 3 bower anchors, 1 stream anchor and 265 fathoms of chain cable, which is 65 fathoms below Rule requirements, and it is recommended this be supplied at the first opportunity.

The equipment has now been retested by Surveyors of this Society.

"Subject to 60 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the first opportunity".
