At the boiler survey on the above vessel in September last it was noted that several generator tubes were sagged. As new tubes were unavailable at the time your surveyor at Birkenhead agreed that the vessel proceed provided new tubes were ordered and fitted at the next opportunity.

The vessel is at present being strapped at Birkenhead but we are still unable to obtain the new tubes required although they have been on order since September last. Your local surveyor at Birkenhead has requested us, through our superintendent there, to contact you for confirmation that it will be in order for him to accept the boiler for survey in its present condition.

As the boiler has steamed without trouble for the past eight months, we trust that you will agree to the boiler being accepted on this occasion and we shall have the fault rectified at the next refit.
