S. I beg to acquaint you that the case of the Tanker "THELIDOMUS" has recently received consideration in view of the survey carried out by the Society's Surveyors at Liverpool in September last.

As a result of this inspection the notation of "LOCAL Classification Contemplated, Carrying petroleum in bulk" has been assigned with Docking Date 9,47 Bkn., subject to No.3 tank being tested before different grades of oil are carried in Nos. 2 and 3 tanks, to the equipment being brought up to Rule requirements, also the machinery spare gear and the electrical fittings in the centre castle 'tween deck space being replaced with fittings of flame proof type. A record of "Examined 9,47" valid for 12 months has also been assigned together with records of BS 9,47 and TS 9,47 (CL) in respect of the Boiler and Screwshaft Surveys.
