With reference to Liverpool Report No.126099 on the Steamer "TENAGODUS", it is noted that the scantlings of the vessel so far as seen were found to agree with the midship section, and it is concluded a First Entry Report embodying the items dealt with will be forwarded in due course.

Similar remarks apply to the case of the "THELIDOMUS", Liverpool Report No.126100.

In the case of the last named ship, I shall be obliged if you will request the Surveyors to state in what respects the ship's side boiler blow down valves depart from Rule requirements.
