Nature of Survey

This tanker was built in 1945 and classed with the American Bureau of Shipping.

The vessel has the temporary class 100A1 "(Classification Contemplated)" assigned and notation of "Examined 10.47".

The GALVESTON Surveyor, in a First Entry Report and Rpt. 8, reports 6.48 the vessel placed in dry dock, the scantlings and arrangements verified, the requirements for Vessels Not Built Under Survey and of a Periodical Special Survey complied with.


The deck, bottom and side shell have been cut and strapped at this time.

The vessel has now on board 3 bower anchors, 1 stream anchor and 300 fathoms of chain cable, which is 30 fathoms below Rule requirements, and it is recommended this be supplied at the first opportunity.

The equipment has been tested by the American Bureau of Shipping and, it is submitted, can be accepted for the figure "1", the notation of Lloyd's A & CP being omitted.

"Subject to repairs to indented shell plating (p.s.), to oil gutterways being fitted in E.R. and to 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the first opportunity".

100A1 "Carrying Petroleum in bulk" "Fitted for oil fuel FP. above 150°F".


