The SWANSEA Surveyors report this T2 Tanker placed in dry dock and the greater part of a Special Survey (B) carried out for Classification as per Circular No.1871.

TO COMPLETE S.S:-

Internal examination of cargo tanks except No.1 (s.s) and No.2 (centre).

Testing of all cargo tanks.

O.F. deep tanks, forward and aft, to be examined internally and tested.

Main scantlings to be verified with plans.

The Surveyors recommend a notation of "Examined 10.47" be assigned meantime.

It is submitted the vessel is eligible to have the class of 100A1 (Classification Contemplated) with record of docking survey 10.47 and the notation of "Examined 10.47" valid for 12 months assigned.
