With reference to your letter of the 20th ultimo and previous correspondence regarding the proposed classification of the above vessel, I have to acquaint you that it has only now been possible to obtain typical drawings relating to the machinery of T2 Tankers, and accordingly it is thought well to forward herewith photostat copies of a complete set for your information and guidance in dealing with the above vessel.
