We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 192 building by Messrs. FEDERAL SHIP-BUILDING AND DRY DOCK COMPANY for Messrs. SINCLAIR REFINING COMPANY of 10,000 GROSS Tons. Length 505' B.P. Breadth 72'0" , Depth 38'0" intended to be Classed 100+ A.I.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connection therewith.

This request is made upon the terms the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
