With reference to the hawser equipment of Messrs Bartram & Sons No. 215 equipment No. 31070 letter X, I have to state that the Owners take exception to the 7" manilla ropes required by Rule which they consider too large for their purpose, and would prefer to place 6" ropes on board.

The equipment they propose is as follows:-

Two - 120 fathoms 3" wire ropes, and

Four- 120 fathoms 6" manilas.

Rule requirements:-

Four- 90 fathoms 7" Manilas.

The tow-line and other equipment will be as per rule.

The approved Midship Section is enclosed for reference.

The matter is respectfully submitted for consideration.
