

EX-GERMAN STEAMER "WILH. HEMSOTH".

Mr. Barnett called here today and stated that the above steamer has been acquired by the Pentwyn S.S. Co., of Baltic House, Cardiff. The vessel is in this port, and will be placed in dry dock for examination. They propose to submit her for survey with a view to classification with this Society.

Mr. Barnett states that the Owners will be writing in making a formal application for this survey.

It is submitted the London Surveyors be advised, and instructed to visit the vessel if placed in dry dock.

At the same time they might be informed that with a view to meeting the wishes of the Owners of these vessels it has been decided to allow the condition surveys for six-monthly certificates to be carried on for some little time, as it may not suit the new Owners' convenience to carry out at once the special survey for classification. Should the Owners in the case of this vessel desire to postpone the survey for classification for a time, the surveyors will therefore be in order in making a general examination of the vessel with a view to issuing a six-monthly certificate, and such work as is done may be counted as part of the special survey necessary for classification, provided the survey be completed within a reasonable time. Before classification can however be finally considered, it will be necessary that the scantlings and arrangements of the vessel should be reported to this Office on plans or a First Entry Report Form, for the consideration of the Committee.
