Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th instant regarding the freeboard assigned to the steamer "PENTEIFI", and in reply to your enquiry on behalf of the Owners I have to point out that the freeboard given in the provisional certificate issued by the Board of Trade was 7 ft. 5½ in. measured from the iron part awning deck at side, as in the German assignment.

The freeboard now assigned by this Society is 7 ft. 7 in. measured from top of statutory deck line 1½ in. above the iron part awning deck at side, as required to be marked under the British regulations.

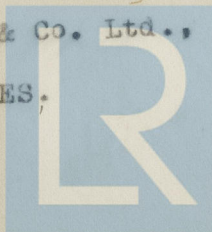
