Steamer "JAMSONS" ex "SUCROSE"

With reference to your report No.15749, I would refer you to my cablegram of the 29th June last and the letter to the Owners of the same date, a copy of which was forwarded to you.

Before this report can receive consideration you should state the period of postponement of the Special Survey warranted as a result of the General Examination held. In all future similar cases where the period of postponement is to be determined by the condition of the ship as found the period of deferment recommended should be stated in the report.

Your letter of the 13th instant relating to the Loadline Certificate has been received, but I would remind you that the maximum period of postponement of the Special Survey which could be granted would be twelve months from the due date of the survey, i.e. Ju 1961. In this respect I would refer you to Chapter B, Paragraph 803 of the Rules.
