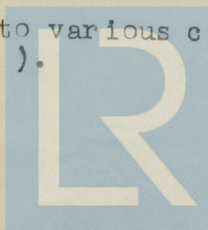

The class is subject to port outside bearing bracket of chain cable lifter being renewed by next Special Survey.

The HELSINGBORG Surveyor reports (9,54), this ship examined in dry dock, bottom coated and the outstanding require of the SPECIALS URVEY (C), previously commenced Cpn. 3,54, not complied with and minor wear and tear repairs effected.

On account of damage due to various causes repairs to side shell plating, etc. (p & s).



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

The port outside bearing bracket of chain cable lifter, as above, has been specially examined, continues efficient and now recommended to be again examined and dealt with as necessary by 9,55.

The thicknesses of shell plating as ascertained by drilling are as stated above and are considered satisfactory.

IT IS SUBMITTED the ship is eligible to remain as classed, with record of docking 9,54 and Notation of 'ss.Lrk. 9,54(Dr)' assigned, subject to port outside bearing bracket of chain cable lifter being examined and dealt with as necessary by 9,55.
