Messrs. Scotts' SB. & E. Co., Ltd., Greenock, surveyed during construction two Steel Air Reservoirs intended for their Engine No. 597, S. S. No. 525. The material has been tested by the Surveyors to this Society. The scantlings are in accordance with the Rules for a working pressure of 355 lbs. per square inch. The Reservoirs were tested in the presence of the undersigned by hydraulic pressure to 583 lbs. per square inch and were found tight at that pressure.

The working pressure should not exceed three hundred and fifty five pounds per square inch.
