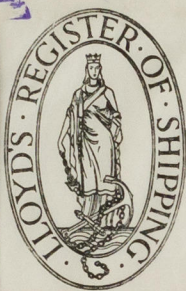

The "JEAN BAPTISTE" has now reached the stage where the engine room double bottom only remains to be demolished and consequently the vessel can now be regarded as no longer suitable for maritime use.
