I am in receipt of your letter of the 1st instant regarding the proposed lengthening of the S.S. "CITY OF DIEPPE", and I note that instead of a 24" x .48" sheer strake doubling as previously arranged, you propose to fit a doubling 18" wide and of a thickness to give the equivalent sectional area of 24" x .48" doubling originally proposed, and that the doubling be fitted clear of the stringer angle riveting, provided the Owners have no objection to this;.

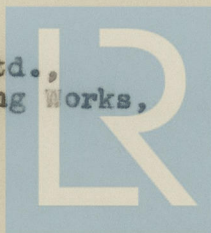
With regard thereto I have to state that these proposals will be approved.

I have also to state that the scantlings as already approved will not be affected on account of the vessel being about 3'-6" longer on the waterline than indicated on your previous submission.
