After discussion with Mr. Turner, Captain Pitt was informed that in addition to the holding of the Donkey Boiler Survey, and Load Line Survey, she should require a General Examination (Drydocking to be left to the Surveyor's discretion), for postponement of the Special Survey.

Special attention to be given to conditions of class.

Captain Pitt agreed to put his request in writing, and asked that a letter be addressed to the Owners confirming our requirements.
