will become due next month.

The class is subject to the upper gudgeon and
post at outer being specially examined at the
drydocking; to a bower anchor and 30 fathoms
main cable being supplied at the earliest opportunity
windlass side frame (starboard side) being renewed
end of June, 1958; also to permanent repairs being
made to leaky engine room sea chest (port side) at
next drydocking.
