My Dear Mr. Dykes,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 8th instant with reference to Leith First Entry Report No. 20665 on the "CORFOSS". This should read  $7/8$  rivets with  $3 \frac{1}{16}$ " spacing in way of the butts of the .61 plates of the upper deck sheerstrake, I regret this error.

With regard to the sister vessels "CORFERRY" and "CORFIELD", although these are prior to my time, on enquiry from the Builders they state  $7/8$ " rivets were also fitted in way of these butts.
