These vessels are of a length to require
six watertight bulkheads to be fitted, but on the profile
plan 5 watertight bulkheads only are shown, the
intermediate bulkhead in the after hold being dispensed
with.

Suitable structural compensation for the omission
of the bulkhead has been provided in the form of a deep
web frame.

A similar arrangement of bulkheads was approved by
the General Committee in the case of the Sister Vessel
"OOTMARSUM", the Builders No.456, for the same Owners, on
the 8th May, 1917, subject to a letter being received from
the Owners requesting the omission of the bulkhead, and
assigning a reason for the same.

A letter was duly received from the Owners
requesting the omission of the bulkhead, to suit the timber
trade, and the following notation was subsequently made
in the Register Book:- "Intermediate bulkhead in after
hold dispensed with 5 BH to Upper Deck".

It is submitted that as these vessels are for the
same Owners, a further letter from the latter regarding the
omission of the bulkheads in the present instances is
unnecessary, and the above notation should be made in the
present cases.
