Dear Sirs,

M. I duly received Mr. Leeuwenburg's letter of the 7th instant respecting the new Steamers Nos. 457/8 proposed to be built by Messrs. A. Vuyk & Zonen, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended be adhered to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with, and the materials and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction, the vessels will be eligible to be classed 100A1.

The steel to be used in the construction of the vessels should be made at works recognised by the Committee and tested by the Society's Surveyors in accordance with the Rules, or as per my letter of 11th February 1915.
