The following alterations now made for access to tonnage space defense
accommodation.

A steel companionway booby hatch fitted on top of tonnage hatch, Port Side,
54" wide, 36" broad, 72" high and 5/16" thick with opening 52" x 24", sill 11" above
top of tonnage hatch and closed by a steel hinged water tight door with dogs manipulated
from both sides.
