March, 1939 and subsequently at the Globe Tube & Engineering Works of Messrs. John Spencer Ltd., for the purpose of testing and inspecting the undernoted Weldless Steel Tubes, made to the order of Messrs. Amos & Smith Ltd., Hull, their order No. 1568:-

- 1 - Bend 4.1/2" o.d. x 1/4" thick, Flanged - Mark "A".
- 1 - Bend 4.1/2" o.d. x 1/4" thick, Loose flanges, Mark "B".

The tubes were submitted for examination in straight lengths and stamped. Material tests were selected from the tubes, tested by the undersigned and found to comply with the requirements of the Rules.

Item Mark "B" was fitted with loose flanges and has not been examined under a hydraulic test.

The Bend, Mark "A", was tested hydraulically to 600 lb. per square inch with satisfactory results and stamped:-
