The vessel and machinery have been built and equipped in accordance with the requirements of the Society for a class 100 A.1 "With freeboard", Subject to 45 fathoms 1.15/16" Tayco Cable being supplied, and record of L.M.C.

All the requirements of the Approved Plans and Ministry of Shipping Specification have been carried out.

Official trials were carried out in the Firth of Clyde on the 28th August, 1941.

Anchor and Steering Gear trials were satisfactory and the main and auxiliary machinery operated efficiently throughout.
