the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners Agents and with the consent of the Master, attend on board the s.s. "CAPTAIN COOK" 13876 gross tons of Glasgow on the 5th November, 1959 whilst lying afloat at this Port for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of damage to the Starboard Propeller, no definite cause known but stated suspected due to Water Barges lying alongside vessel at Curacao on the 6th October, 1959.

Damage stated first observed by member of crew at Wellington New Zealand on the 4th November, 1959.

The services of the Wellington Harbour Board skin diver were obtained and upon his examination the following damage was found and repairs recommended by the undersigned without prejudice to the terms and conditions of insurance.

FOUND

Starboardside Propeller,
one blade tip slightly bent
and segment of adjoining
blade tip missing.

RECOMMENDED

That propeller blades be
repaired as necessary.

The foregoing recommendation was made with a view to placing the vessel in the same good and efficient condition as before the alleged casualty occurred but owing to the vessel's commitments and at the instance of the Owners repairs have been deferred until the vessel's next dry docking and an interim certificate issued recommending that the Starboard Propeller be specially examined and dealt with as necessary next dry-docking.
