The Ship was last examined in dry dock 8,57 and she was reported laid up in February 1952.

The SINGAPORE Surveyors report (9,59), ship examined afloat and her condition found satisfactory for the proposed voyage in tow to Hong Kong as an unclassified hulk.

In view of the above IT IS SUBMITTED the proposal to tow the ship to Hong Kong as an unclassified hulk merits approval but ACTION be DEFERRED pending further information.
