I have to acquaint you that from a First Entry Report received from the Society's Surveyor at Barrow it appears that the S.S. "ENDCLIFFE" recently built by Mr. W. Walker, of Maryport, has proceeded to your port where her machinery is to be fitted.

To complete the survey on the hull the Engine and Boiler casings require to be riveted up and the rudder stops to be examined and tested.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will arrange for the case to receive the necessary attention and on completion of the work for a report to be forwarded on Form 8 in the usual manner for the information of the Committee with a view to the classification of the vessel.
