Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in ✓

Alterations carried out in connexion with fitting vessel to carry & pump sand
in bulk in the Bristol Channel.

A steel tank has been constructed in the vessel's hold below the hatch
into which the sand-laden water is pumped by a centrifugal pump on deck. To permit
of surplus top-water to drain away, holes 18×9 " have been cut in the hatch side
coamings above the deck (2 forward & 2 aft). Welded steel trunks lead from these holes
overboard through the bulwarks. Two portable sluice doors are fitted in each trunk, one
at hatch & one at bulwark. ✓ Doors attached to vessel by chains.

The existing hatch has been shortened at fore end by 3 frame spaces
(5'-3") & space forward of hatch, beamed & plated over & reinforced with 3 intersecting
longitudinal girders to take the sand pump. ✓ New beams are of same size as existing
full width beams & scarfed onto existing 2 beams. Thickness of new deck plating $\frac{5}{8}$ ".

An access hatch (20" x 20", coaming $\frac{3}{8}$ " thick) to the hold has been
constructed aft of the forecastle front bulkhead, in place of a hold ventilator. Hatch is
of same height as main hatch & is closed by hinged steel cover made watertight by 2
tarpaulins with battening bars & wedges.
