In forwarding Form Rpt 11b. for the S.S. No. 369 building at Dartmouth by Messrs. Philip & Son, Ltd., I beg to inform you that on applying to the firm (in accordance with the Instructions to Surveyors) for a separate midship section for the above vessel they replied they would do so if I sent them the approved tracing. This was forwarded to the London Office on the 2nd June in connection with the 1st entry report of the Sister Vessel No. 368 and I requested in my letter of the 6th June that the plans for No. 368 might be returned to this office for guidance in connection with No. 369.

With regard to measurements on Freeboard Form herewith I beg to state that they were taken (on the blocks) before vessel was launched also, that there are no side scuttles to affect the position of the load line disc.
