In reply, I am pleased to inform you that provided an opportunity is afforded the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff to make a General Examination of the ship, prior to her proceeding on the contemplated voyage, and she be found satisfactory, the Committee will be prepared to maintain her class until her arrival in the Far East, which is anticipated to be in November next. I would take advantage of this opportunity to remind you that the existing Load Line Certificate will expire on the 1st August next, and if a further Load Line Certificate is desired, it will be necessary for a Load Line Survey to be held.

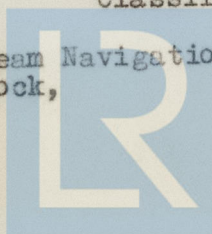
It will, therefore, be appreciated if in due course you will kindly inform me where such an inspection can receive attention, should you require another certificate,
