me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am
recommending that she be retained as classed without fresh record of
docking subject to ventilator coamings (2 temporarily
repaired) in way of Nos. 1 and 3 tween decks being dealt with
if necessary at the Special Survey also indented shell plate
No. 1, J18 (p.s.) from aft and buckled stem bar and adjacent
strake plating (s.s.) being examined and dealt with as
necessary at the next Special Survey and a spare bower anchor
to be supplied at the earliest opportunity, as previously
recommended.


