The above name ship stranded 10 miles North Chittagong still ashore, as far as can be ascertained from ship's Agents now up for sale as she lies, the possibility of refloating looks extremely remote as ship is lying approx.  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile from water at low tide.

All cargo has now been discharged and of the officers only the Master, 3rd Officer and 4th Engineer Officer remain on board.
