Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the case of the Steamer "TROCHISCUS" has today received the consideration of the Committee in view of the survey carried out by the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff in December/February last.

S. As a result of this inspection notations of 100A1 (Classification Contemplated), Carrying petroleum in bulk have been assigned with Docking Date 1,48 Off., subject to indented shell plates (p.s.f) being dealt with at the first convenient opportunity and to 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the first opportunity; also to the suction valves on oil fuel bunkers being made controllable in accordance with the requirements of the Society's Rules.

A notation of "Examined 1,48" valid for 12 months has also been assigned together with records of BS 2,48 and S 1,48 CL in respect of the Boiler and Screwshaft Surveys respectively.
