Outstanding Conditions of Class: SUBJECT to pitted shell plating (p & s amids) being examined at successive drydockings and to lower portion of sternframe and butt (T.W.10,58) being specially examined next drydocking.

Recommendation:

SUBMITTED record of 'DS 8,59' be assigned as recommended, subject as above, and to top pintle of rudder, air pipes to cofferdam (s.s.a) and cross bunker (p.s.a) being specially examined and dealt with before ship is re-commissioned, and to set in shell plates H.7, J.7 & 14, K.17 & 18 (p.s.) and J.12, and K.12 (s.s.), all from fwd, being specially examined and dealt with as found necessary by the Special Survey.
