Nature of Survey

First entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Middlesbrough Surveyors should be informed that this vessel is proceeding to Stockton-on-Tees where it is stated her machinery will be fitted by Messrs. Blair & Co.

To complete the survey on the hull the water tight door and Downton pump require to be tested, the pillars in the Engine & Boiler room, the E & B casings and tunnel top to be riveted and the latter tested.

They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work forward a report on Form 8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
