Scuppers, wash basins and bath wastes from deckhouses above freeboard deck lead overboard above 2nd Deck now fitted with gunmetal automatic non-return valves at Ship's side - 13 valves fitted viz:-

- 1 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 1 - 2" from Engineers accommodation,
- 2 - 2", 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " from Stewards accommodation and 3 - 2" on Port side, 3 - 2" and 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " on Starboard side from midship accommodation.
