Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

REMOVAL OF PASSENGER ACCOMMODATION IN NO. 4 'TWEEN DECK.

The passenger accommodation within the No. 4 'tween deck has now been dispensed with. The single companion situated on the superstructure deck on the port side at the fore end of the No. 5 hatch has been removed and the aperture plated over with .5" steel closing plates, electric welded to the deck plated.

The 4 overboard scuppers on the port side and the one scupper on the starboard side have been removed and the shell apertures have been closed by substantial steel discs electric welded in position.

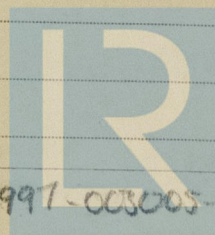
The portlights have been retained but these are now securely closed with the deadlights in position.
