- 12- Cloudy, fine & clear.
- 1- 1215 vessel diverting to Manila for engine repairs A/C $180^{\circ}(T)$ $178^{\circ}(C)$ C/E $2^{\circ}E$.
- 2- Ventilation of holds attended to.
- 3- 1500 Log 24, D.R. Lat $17^{\circ} 13'N$ OBS Long. $119^{\circ} 40\frac{1}{2}'E$
