

This ship has been under survey at Birkenhead

on 12th Sept., 1957 and subsequently 195 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been ~~effected~~/found:—

Washport doors p. & s. on the R.Q. deck, have been removed and replaced by fitting 3 @ $\frac{3}{4}$ " solid round bars spaced 4" apart.

The for'd. well deck wooden gangway between the bridge ladder and the hatch and the hatch and the fo'cle ladder p.s. has been removed as it restricts deck space and access to the crews' quarters in the fo'cle. In view of the height of the bulwarks in the for'd. well this arrangement in my opinion is satisfactory.
