Several minor alterations and additions are being made to meet the requirements of the new Owners, Messrs. Lmay & Cie., and when in dry dock at Rotterdam it is intended to complete some additions to the pumping arrangements. I have duly advised the Rotterdam Surveyors.

On the vessels return from Rotterdam to Caen, the Builders will complete the fitting of two escape hatch coverings on the weather deck. My First Entry Report will be forwarded when the work is satisfactorily completed.
