I beg to inform you that the above vessel sailed loaded from Caen yesterday, and is now bound for Rotterdam where she will enter dry dock after discharging. Several minor alterations and additions are being made to meet the requirements of the new Owners, Messrs. Lmay & Cie., and when in dry dock at Rotterdam it is intended to complete some additions to the pumping arrangements. I have duly advised the Rotterdam Surveyors.

On the vessels return from Rotterdam to Caen, the Builders will complete the fitting of two escape hatch coamings on the weather deck. My First Entry Report will be forwarded when the work is satisfactorily completed.
