The material of these headers was tested in accordance with the requirements of this Society's Rules.

The finished headers were tested in my presence by hydraulic pressure to 650 lbs per square inch with satisfactory results.

10% of the elements were tested in my presence by hydraulic pressure to 2250 lbs per square inch with satisfactory results.

The headers are stamped Nos.C.22,32,35,76,175,184,188, 189,190,192,193,194,195,196,191,A2, and are stamped  for identification.
