## EXAMINATION AND REPAIRS AS PER RULE FOR DAMAGE SURVEY AND TEMPORARY REPAIRS

Attend on board at request of Owners Superintendent on the 4th January, 1958 and subsequent dates whilst the ship was lying afloat in the IJsselhaven at Rotterdam for examination of the cracked holdframe No. 156 p.s. at about 10' draught.

In connection with the above the following temporary repairs have been carried out.

Riveted reverse bar fitted 11" x 4" x 50" in way of crack 40" in length (20" above and below crack) by means of 3/4" rivets.

After repairs shell in way hosed tested and found tight.

It was agreed with Owners Superintendent that it is recommended permanent repairs to be carried out at next drydocking.
