on 29th June 1956 and the following alterations to the conditions of
assignment of loadlines have now been effected/changed:—

Eight open overboard scuppers (4p & 4s) draining bridge tween decks now
blanked off at shell with welded steel plates and the tubes filled with
cement. ✓

Two (1p & 1s) 4 inch diameter scupper pipes now fitted in upper deck within
bridge for draining bridge tween decks. Both pipes led to engine room
bilges, their lower ends being in easily accessible positions and fitted
with self-closing, weighted lever cocks. ✓ Intermediate bulkheads
in bridge fitted with drain holes at wings. ✓
