

ANGLO MÆRSK. — New York, Apr. 23, motor ship reported exploded at 15 45 N., longitude 100 15 W., abandoned ship. The cause of the explosion was not ascertained at the scene. The ship was taken on board the Anglo Mærsk fire insurance company's master plans on Apr. 24. The estimated value of the ship was \$100,000.
