Dear Sir,

You will see from your records that the Special Survey on the S.S. "TREFOIL" belonging to the Mersey Docks & Harbour Board is four months overdue, and that she has not been docked since June, 1955. The Dock Board are experimenting with another ship to do the work which the "TREFOIL" has been carrying out. If this arrangement continues to be successful the "TREFOIL" will not be put through survey again and will be put up for sale. At the moment the ship is laid-up and the Owners have promised to inform me as soon as a definite decision is made to sell her, or if they do decide to place her in commission again.
